

USING *MyMathLab* (CourseCompass) WITHOUT:

- ACCESS TO A HOME COMPUTER OR
- HIGH SPEED INTERNET



If you have off campus computer issues (no access to a computer, dial up instead of high speed internet, etc.), you will still be able to use *MyMathLab* – but with a little bit of extra effort.

1. Print the homework assignment (not quizzes) from *MyMathLab*.

- Login to *MyMathLab*
- Click on the assignment you want to print
- Click on **Question 1**
- On the right hand side of the page, click PRINT
- Choose PRINT THE ASSIGNMENT
- Click PRINT (wait for the assignment to load)
- Choose the appropriate printer and print.
- Before leaving campus with your assignment(s), double check that you have ALL pages and questions – comparing it to the assignment on the computer screen. Remember, it is your responsibility to do the **complete** assignment either on or before the due date.

2. Take the homework assignment with you and complete the work.

3. Input your answers on campus:

- You **SHOULD enter ALL THE ANSWERS for every question you have completed** before retrying any question that is marked incorrect. (This is because whenever you ask for a “new” question or use a help function, the subsequent questions may regenerate with new numbers and your current answers will be incorrect for the new problems.)
- After inputting ALL YOUR ANSWERS, you can now go back and rework any questions that were answered incorrectly. You can also use the help functions (located at the right while inside of a question).

4. Be aware of DUE DATES!!!

- Print and work assignments well in advance of the DUE DATE.
- You will be working the assignment at home using pencil and paper, but you will still need to enter your answers and possibly make corrections on a campus computer in the future. Therefore you always want to be working at least one or two days prior to the due date of any particular assignment.
- Always make sure you have arrangements to use a campus computer and the time to do so.

5. You can only work HOMEWORK away from a computer, not QUIZZES.

- If your instructor is using *MyMathLab* for quizzes, be sure to make the time in your schedule to **work quizzes while on campus** – using a campus computer.
- Using computers in the Mathematics Laboratory PS015 is suggested – you will have access to tutors and/or close proximity to your instructor.
